2024 Trojan Cup

This year, in conjunction with the two-day Rum City Classic race event, the Bundaberg Powerboat Club is honoured to host the final meeting of The Trojan Cup, after a 20-year legacy.

In the heart of 6-litre Australian powerboat racing, one name stands out among the roaring engines and water spray - Larry Martin. Larry had been racing for around 20 years and during this time had been awarded the Australian championship holder for Windsor in 1990. Unfortunately, Larry tragically lost his life during the 2004 Bundy Thunder spectacular. Following this tragedy, it was not long before a race would be held in Larry's honour and so the "Trojan Cup" was born.

The Trojan Cup has captivated crowds with its blend of speed, skill and V8 engine roar. It stands as a testament to the enduring passion for powerboat racing and the unwavering dedication of all those who have and continue to contribute to its rich history.

Over the years, the Trojan Cup has evolved into a cornerstone event in the Australian powerboat calendar. The sport has seen its share of legendary drivers, iconic races, rivalries form with records being set and broken. 6-litre powerboat racing in Australia is a thrilling motorsport that combines speed, skill, noise and adrenaline on the water. This class has pushed the boundaries of powerboat engine performance and design. Australian powerboat engine builders are regarded as amongst the best in the world. This class of powerboat racing is known for their impressive acceleration and cornering. One of the key attractions of the 6-litre class is the competitiveness of the boats and the skill of the drivers



Camping Area

- Camping is limited to **drivers, crews and those directly associated with a competing team.**
- The sites are not available to general public or tourists.
- First in best dressed – we will not be holding sites. Please book and pay, and send a receipt of payment to bundabergpowerboats@gmail.com If you have not booked and paid prior to 15th July, you will not gain entry.
- The camping area (above Ramp 1) will be **open from Wednesday 24th July from 8am and will be locked again Tuesday 30th July at 4pm.**
- Please make sure you have vacated by this time and have left the area clean, tidy and rubbish free.
- A skip bin and extra toilets will be available. **No public showers or electricity is available on site.**
- Fees are \$50.00 per site for the event period above.
- Maximum 4 people per site.
- Bookings and payment **must be made by Monday 15th July** to confirm & gain entry.

- **Camping areas will be marked** out with an allocation of **6m x 16m**. The river side and adjacent (north to south) will be a 'designated pit area' for campers who have a boat and are racing. Caravans will need to park in a north/south direction. Volunteers and non-racers will need to park along the back of the camping area (east to west) to allow for boats and races to access the ramps. The front of the camping area will be designated for the club trailer and club officials.

Pit Area

- **Adequate covered footwear** must be worn by all team members and spectators wishing to enter the pit area.
- **No smoking/naked flames or consumption of alcohol** is allowed in the pit area.
- Any team found to be **in breach of these rules will be disqualified** from the event and asked to leave the pit area.
- Each boat will have an area of 3m and allowed to have **1 tow vehicle** in the pit area to reduce congestion of the area.
- *Please ask all visitors to park in the top car park – cars parked in the bottom carpark will be asked to leave or removed.*
- **Spectators are not allowed to set up a marquee in this area.**

Scrutineering

- Scrutineers will be available on Friday.
- All boats must be scrutineered prior to 8am Saturday 27th July 2024.
- Once your boat is scrutineered, no further modifications or changes can be made. If changes or modifications are made, your boat will need to be rescrutinised.
- State Boating Licence and Boat Registration documentation must be shown at both scrutineering and nomination when requested.
- Cell Test Confirmation letter from within the last 12 months must be provided for any cell boat.
- Each boat can only enter one class.

Drug and alcohol Testing

- All drivers must complete a breath test prior to practice and each race day.
- Random testing may take place throughout the weekend and all drivers and crew will be asked to comply.

Planned Itinerary

- **Friday**
 - **Scrutineering** – from 12noon
 - **Practice** – 9am – 4pm – Full race gear must be worn during the practice session and breathalyser competed. No boat is to enter the course without permission from Officer of the Day.
- **Saturday**
 - **Scrutineering** – 7am to 8am
 - **Drivers Briefing** – 8.15am – All drivers must attend – No boats are to be running during this time.
 - **Racing** – 9am – 4pm
- **Sunday**
 - **Drivers Briefing** – 8.15am – All drivers must attend – No boats are to be running during this time.
 - **Racing** – 9am – 4pm
 - **Presentation** - 5pm – Sandy Hook Ski Club.

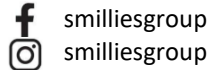

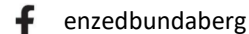
